



## **ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT**

In addition to ensuring compliance with current environmental and Health and Safety requirements for all our products or material used, the management team is taking positive steps to:

- Reduce the amount of waste material generated.
- Recycle waste material eg. offcuts, swarf.
- Recycle packaging.
- Use environmentally friendly alternatives where reasonably practicable.
- Assess the requirements and implications of new legislation.
- Avoid materials considered Ozone – depleting.
- Avoid substances listed in RoHS regulations
- Encourage employee suggestions of improvement

This is in accordance with the ENSINGER Group Ltd policy. All materials purchased from our associate companies are produced and supplied in accordance with the environmental legislation existing in the country of origin, namely Germany, USA and Italy.
